

What to Bring to Camp

Most activities occur outside, so bring clothes for outdoor activities. This includes warmer clothes for cool nights and mornings. Two outfits a day is suggested. Plus, it may rain so be prepared!!!

- Swimwear - See Dress Code
- Wrangler campers must have long pants/jeans and boots/closed toe shoes
- Shoes that could get wet or muddy, closed toe shoes such as tennis shoes (Chaco's don't count as closed toe), spare shoes if possible and shower sandals. If campers don't have tennis shoes, they cannot participate in some of the activities.
- Towels for bathing, towels for swimming, washcloths, soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, and any other hygiene products, spare contacts, etc.
- Bring any medications in labeled bottles – these must be given to the nurse upon arrival
- Bug spray and sun block (**Ivy block if the camper is sensitive to poison ivy/oak**)
- Bible
- Pen/Pencil
- Pillow, sheets and blankets or a sleeping bag
- Flashlight
- Bag for dirty clothes
- Bring money for missions and the camp store if you wish
- **BRING A FRIEND**

- Cell Phones

- Cell phone use is at the Dean's discretion

- *Campers bring cell phones at their own risk. The camp is not responsible for the loss, damage or theft of cell phones and recommends leaving cell phones at home. The deans, nurse and camp managers allow campers to call parents using the camp phone any time it is necessary.*

What not to bring

- Snacks.

- Campers are well fed with 3 full meals and snacks and canteen. There is no food or candy allowed in the cabins. Food attracts mice and insects and we don't want them to visit our cabins!

- Knives or guns

- Tobacco/Alcohol/Drugs

- Faith Christian Camp is a tobacco free campus.**

DRESS CODE

Modest clothing must be worn at all times.

Unacceptable clothing includes:

For girls:

Two piece bathing suits

Short shorts

Slit shorts

Any shirt that does not cover the entire midriff

Spaghetti straps

Tube tops

See-through tops

For Boys:

Brief “racer” style swim trunks

Low sagging pants

Shirts that are ripped down the side

Boys must wear a shirt at all times.

All:

Shoes must be worn **at all times** except at the water slide. NO flip flops allowed on playground or when playing games. Clothing that advertises alcohol, tobacco, or other objectionable material is prohibited.

No clothes with lettering across buttocks.

You may be asked to change if your clothing is considered inappropriate.
