Qualifications	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Have an authentic and growing relationship with Jesus Christ</li> <li>• Be an active member of a Christian Church/Church of Christ</li> <li>• Be willing to affirm Faith Christian Camp's Statement of Faith</li> <li>• Have a desire to serve others</li> <li>• Possess current Adult and Pediatric First Aid/CPR/AED certification through American Red Cross, or equivalent. Higher training preferred, but not required to apply.</li> <li>• Have a teachable spirit and a willingness to step in where needed</li> <li>• Be physically and mentally able to work long hours, including evenings and weekends when needed.</li> <li>• Be physically and mentally capable of being woken up in the middle of the night and offer care with a good attitude.</li> <li>• Be willing to spend the entire summer on site, with any time off approved by the Camp Director in advance</li> </ul>
Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Maintain Christian Conduct at all times</li> <li>• Be "on call" any time there are campers on the property, this includes being on call overnight.</li> <li>• Provide routine and emergency first aid care</li> <li>• Keep first aid kits, and First Aid Station stocked with necessary medical supplies</li> <li>• At weekly camper check in, do a basic health screening to including searching for lice, and speak to parents about specific health concerns.</li> <li>• At the end of the week, insure medication is given back to campers parents.</li> <li>• Distribute all prescribed medication, and keep a record of distribution</li> <li>• Act as Camp Photographer, taking pictures of campers during each week of camp</li> <li>• Be ready and willing to step in wherever needed</li> <li>• Regularly clean and sanitize the First Aid Station, and first aid attendant living quarters.</li> <li>• Maintain a good attitude at all times</li> <li>• Other assigned duties</li> </ul>
